Signal Proxy Intelligence Recommends **FOR** on GRAHAM CORPORATION Ballot Items Ahead of August 25, 2026 Annual Meeting

Independent research firm publishes item-by-item recommendations on all 5 ballot measures within 5 hours of the company's proxy filing.

NEW YORK, NY — Signal Proxy Intelligence, the independent proxy research division of Signal Law Group, today published its recommendations on the August 25, 2026 annual meeting of GRAHAM CORPORATION. The firm issued a recommendation on each of the 5 items on the ballot, published 5 hours after the company's definitive proxy statement was accepted on EDGAR.

Reviewing the ballot from the perspective of the common shareholder and using publicly available information only, Signal assigned the meeting a concern band of **Routine**. Signal recommends FOR the advisory vote on named executive officer compensation, noting that approximately 96% of votes cast supported say-on-pay at the 2025 annual meeting.

"We support Graham Corporation's routine ballot, including the election of James J. Barber, Mauro Gregorio, and Troy A. Stoner, the advisory say-on-pay proposal that drew approximately 96% support at the 2025 annual meeting, and the ratification of Deloitte & Touche LLP after the Audit Committee said permitted non-audit services did not compromise independence. This recommendation reflects the public filing and is entered into the ledger for reconciliation against the company's reported vote."

On the election of directors, Signal recommends FOR each of the 3 nominees — James J. Barber, Mauro Gregorio, Troy A. Stoner — with the filing disclosing no governance concerns regarding any nominee. Signal also recommends FOR the ratification of Deloitte & Touche LLP as the company's independent registered public accounting firm, citing no auditor independence or accounting concerns in the filing. Where the firm's recommendations diverge from those of the incumbent proxy advisors, the divergence and its basis are documented in the full report.
