SPI issued a recommendation on each of the 3 items on the ballot, published 34 hours after the company's definitive proxy statement was accepted on EDGAR.

Reviewing the ballot from the perspective of the common shareholder and using publicly available information only, SPI assigned the meeting a concern band of Elevated. Signal recommends **AGAINST** the Adjournment Proposal because the filing states the meeting could be adjourned to solicit additional votes in favor of the proposals.

"We support Sphere 3D's continuance proposal because the filing says it would provide increased flexibility and facilitate the proposed name change, and we also support the name change because the filing states the new name may better reflect the company's current core business. We oppose the adjournment proposal, which the filing presents as a way to seek additional votes in favor of the proposals. This recommendation reflects the public filing and is entered into the ledger for reconciliation against the company's reported vote."
